#### DESCRIPTION AND USES

**MINI 2000 can be used in two different ways :**

- To take the azimuth bearing of a distant point, hold the compass in one hand, with the thumb under the instrument and the other four fingers on top of it, the fingertips being aligned along the prism housing. Maintain the compass near the eye, resting it against the wing of the nose. The card, with graduation every degree and figure indication every 5°, can be seen 10 times magnified through the prism. Look at the point, placing it above the prism. The reading of the graduation seen below this point gives its bearing.

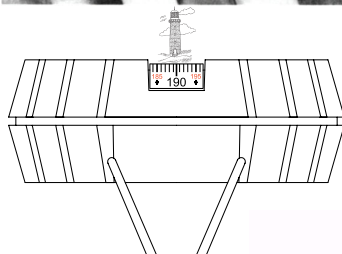
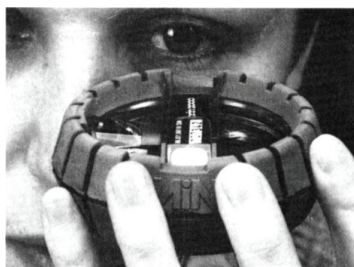
In case of failure of the main compass, it is possible to use the MINI 2000 as an emergency compass; you have then to proceed as follows :

- First method: Place yourself on the longitudinal axis of the boat (same longitudinal plane as the keel).

On a sailboat, aim at the front stay. The bearing read is the magnetic course followed by the boat. You can thus, by means of successive aims, check periodically the course followed.

On a motor boat, the aim is made according to the lubber line of the boat.

- Second method: Place the MINI 2000 near you, as near as possible, in order to make easier its reading. Through the conical magnifying glass on the right side of the aim axis, the graduation on the card can be read.

The mark engraved on the compass back-plate must be orientated in order to be parallel to the keel (or to the lubber of the steering compass) : the value read opposite the mark under the conical magnifying glass is that of the course followed by the boat.

- You must keep away from another magnetic compass. Avoid putting the compass too close to magnetic metal masses (such as certain eye-glasses frames, wrist-watches) which may cause a variation.

#### MAINTENANCE

Wipe the compass with a fine and clean cloth. If necessary, clean it with slightly soapy water.

**Never use solvents such as alcohol, ether, benzene, gasoline, etc.**

#### WARNING

Do not remove compass from rubber collar. Do not expose to a temperature over 60°C.

#### WARRANTY
